Google Drive	
Pro	Con
Upload automatically makes everything a mp4.	Not everyone has a Google account.
It is user-friendly and compatible with any type of email for sharing with judges.	Some students with school Google accounts, cannot share outside of the school server.
Video files can be downloaded if necessary.	
School or personal accounts can be used.	
Dropbox	
It is free and can save many types of files.	Sharing is difficult.
Video files can be downloaded if necessary.	Dropbox is not widely used by students.
One Drive	
Offers 15GBs of free storage space.	Must create an account if the school district is not contracted with Microsoft.
Can save all types of files.	Limited encryption and sharing options.
Students do not need to create an account if the school district is contracted with Microsoft.	Privacy concerns--Microsoft reserves the right to scan files and look for copyrighted material.
Streamable	
No account necessary.	Cannot download the video if necessary.
Provides a direct link to the video stream.	
We Transfer	
Students do not need to create an account.	Maximum file share is 2GB.
Students receive confirmation that their file has been downloaded by the coordinator.	Coordinators must download the file and upload to another streaming program for judge access.
	Files are deleted after seven days.
