JUDGING A VIRTUAL NHD CONTEST

Rules and procedures that apply to a virtual contest

EXHIBIT CATEGORY

- All materials (ENTRY AND ACCOMPANYING PAPERWORK) received by judges through the registration system
- Evaluation Form completed and submitted through the registration system

For Regional Contests in Texas students have three options for creating and submitting exhibit entries.

OPTION 1: Create a physical exhibit

- Students will photograph their exhibit and create a set of slides using Google Slides or PowerPoint that will be converted into a PDF for submission
- No more than 20 slides
- One slide must be a photograph of the entire exhibit
- Other slides will be photos of separate sections of the exhibit with accompanying text
- Any media hyperlinked on the PDF document

OPTION 2: Create a Virtual Exhibit using Google Slides or Microsoft PowerPoint

- Exhibit cannot be more than 20 slides
- Slides cannot be more than 20 inches by 20 inches
- Font size for student composed words should be 16 pt or larger
- Font size for image credits should be at least 12 pt or larger
- Any media hyperlinked on the PDF document

OPTION 3: Create a Virtual Exhibit using Design Software such as Google Draw or Microsoft Publisher

- Students will create the exhibit on one slide that illustrates the entire exhibit
- Judges will be able to zoom in to see detail and read text
- The entire exhibit page size cannot be more than 74 inches wide and 72" high to represent the dimensions of a physical exhibit
